VISION

The vision of Bayou City Blessings is to work collaboratively with partner schools to remove childhood hunger as a non-academic barrier to learning so that all children have the opportunity to experience academic success.

MISSION

Bayou City Blessings mobilizes our local community, individuals and resources to provide food on the weekends and during school breaks for Houston children who might otherwise go hungry. Our mission serves to raise awareness of childhood hunger by building community and establishing relationships with our educational partners to improve the lives of Houston children.

FEEDING HEARTS & BELLIES

As a part of Blessings in a Backpack national network and a ministry of Holy Spirit Episcopal Church, Bayou City Blessings launched in 2012 to feed hungry children who reside in Houston area "food deserts," areas that have limited access to affordable, nutritions food. That year, Bayou City Blessings provided weekend food for 60 students at one school in Houston's Third Ward. Since then, tireless volunteers and generous donors have partnered with Bayou City Blessings, making it possible to provide weekend food to over 2,500 hungry children in the 2022-23 school year.

HOW IT WORKS & WHAT IT MEANS

Children receive weekend food bags every Friday to bridge the gap between Friday lunch and Monday breakfast. This helps to ensure students arrive to school on Monday ready to learn, eliminating hungry weekends and preparing their minds and bodies to learn, grow and develop.



A typical bag contains chili, goldfish, apple sauce, graham crackers, cereal cup, milk and raisins.




